Legislative Accomplishments

Congressmember Mike Levin has proudly sponsored or co-sponsored the following legislation:

H.R. 1 - For the People Act of 2019: Expands voting rights, would make election day a federal holiday, and reduces the influence of big money in politics.

H.R. 4 - Voting Rights Advancement Act of 2019: Protects voting rights in areas with a history of voter discrimination.

H.R. 5 - Equality Act: To prohibit discrimination on the basis of sex, gender identity, and sexual orientation.

H.R. 6 - American Dream and Promise Act: To authorize the cancellation of removal and adjustment of status of certain immigrants.

H.R. 7 - Paycheck Fairness Act: Eliminates pay discrimination on the basis of sex. Equal pay for equal work.

H.R. 8 - (Bipartisan) Background Checks Act of 2019: Requires background checks on all firearm sales.

H.R. 9 - Climate Action Now Act: To direct the President to develop a plan for the United States to meet its nationally determined contribution under the Paris Agreement.

H.R. 31 - (Bipartisan) Caesar Syria Civilian Protection Act of 2019: To sanction the Syrian Regime for its malign activities.

H.R. 36 - (Bipartisan) Combating Sexual Harassment in Science Act of 2019: Addresses sexual harassment in the science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) fields by supporting sexual harassment research and efforts to prevent and respond to sexual harassment.

H.R. 51 - Washington, D.C. Admission Act: To admit Washington, Douglass Commonwealth into the Union on an equal footing with the other states.

H.R. 67 - (Bipartisan) Federal Employee Retroactive Pay Fairness Act: Ensures that all federal employees who were furloughed due to the government shutdown receive their back pay.

H.R. 95 - (Bipartisan) Homeless Veteran Families Act: To ensure that children of homeless veterans are included in the calculation of the amounts of certain per diem grants.

H.R. 141 - (Bipartisan) Social Security Fairness Act of 2019: To repeal the Government pension offset and windfall elimination provisions.

H.R. 188 - (Bipartisan) Securing Access to Lower Taxes by ensuring (SALT) Deductibility Act: To repeal the limitation on individual tax deductions for certain state and local taxes.

H.R. 230 - Ban Toxic Pesticides Act of 2019: To cancel the registration of all uses of the pesticide chlorpyrifos.

H.R. 279 - California Clean Coast Act of 2019: Protects the California coast from offshore drilling.

H.R. 299 - (Bipartisan) Blue Water Navy Vietnam Veterans Act of 2019: To provide health coverage to those exposed to agent orange while serving in the Navy off the coast of Vietnam.

H.R. 309 - Stop Arctic Ocean Drilling Act of 2019: To prohibit drilling in the Arctic Ocean.

H.R. 310 - West Coast Ocean Protection Act of 2019: Prevents offshore drilling off the coast of California, Washington, and Oregon.

H.R. 397 - (Bipartisan) Rehabilitation for Multiemployer Pensions Act of 2019: To establish a Pension Rehabilitation Administration within the Department of the Treasury to make loans to multiemployer defined benefit plans.

H.R. 510 - (Bipartisan) Building Rail Access for Customers and the Economy (BRACE) Act of 2019: To permanently extend the tax credit for railroad track maintenance.

H.R. 541 - Keep Families Together Act: To limit the separation of families at or near ports of entry.

H.R. 550 - (Bipartisan) Merchant Mariners of World War II Congressional Gold Medal Act of 2019: To award a Congressional Gold Medal, collectively, to the United States Merchant Mariners of World War II, in recognition of their dedicated and vital service during World War II.

H.R. 553 - (Bipartisan) Military Surviving Spouses Equity Act: To repeal the requirement for reduction of survivor annuities under the Survivor Benefit Plan for military surviving spouses to offset the receipt of veterans dependency and indemnity compensation.

H.R. 555 - (Bipartisan) Disability Integration Act of 2019: To prohibit discrimination against individuals with disabilities who need long-term services and support.

H.R. 582 - Raise the Wage Act: Would gradually increase the Federal minimum wage.

H.R. 587 - (Bipartisan) To posthumously award the Congressional Gold Medal, collectively, to Glen Doherty, Tyrone Woods, J. Christopher Stevens, and Sean Smith, in recognition of their contributions to the Nation.

H.R. 641 - Agricultural Worker Program Act of 2019: To improve agricultural job opportunities, benefits, and security for aliens in the United States.

H.R. 647 - (Bipartisan) Palliative Care and Hospice Education and Training Act: To increase the number of permanent faculty in palliative care at accredited allopathic and osteopathic medical schools, nursing schools, social work schools, and other programs,

including physician assistant education programs, to promote education and research in palliative care and hospice, and to support the development of faculty careers in academic palliative medicine.

H.R. 657 - Immediate Financial Relief for Federal Employees Act: To provide loans to employees of the Federal Government and the government of the District of Columbia affected by a Government shutdown.

H.R. 663 - (Bipartisan) Burn Pits Accountability Act: To direct the Secretary of Defense to include periodic health assessments, separation history and physical examinations, and other assessments to evaluate whether a member of the Armed Forces has been exposed to open burn pits or toxic airborne chemicals.

H.R. 693 - (Bipartisan) U.S. Senator Joseph D. Tydings Memorial Prevent All Soring Tactics (PAST) Act of 2019: To amend the Horse Protection Act to designate additional unlawful acts under the Act, strengthen penalties for violations of the Act, and improve Department of Agriculture enforcement of the Act. Specifically to prevent the practice of soring horses.

H.R. 724 - (Bipartisan) Preventing Animal Cruelty and Torture (PACT) Act: Prevents animal cruelty and torture.

H.R. 728 - (Bipartisan) Title VIII Nursing Workforce Reauthorization Act of 2019: To extend advanced education nursing grants to support clinical nurse specialist programs.

H.R. 737 - (Bipartisan) Shark Fin Sales Elimination Act: To prohibit the sale of shark fins.

H.R. 748 - (Bipartisan) Middle Class Health Benefits Tax Repeal Act of 2019: To repeal the excise tax on high cost employer-sponsored health coverage.

H.R. 763 - Energy Innovation & Carbon Dividend Act of 2019: This bill imposes a fee on the carbon content of fossil fuels, including crude oil, natural gas, oil, or any other product derived from those fuels that will be used so as to emit greenhouse gases into the atmosphere.

H.R. 810: To block the implementation of certain presidential actions that restrict individuals from certain countries from entering the United States.

H.R. 860 - Social Security 2100 Act: Protects and strengthens our social security system for current and future generations.

H.R. 865 - Rebuild America's Schools Act of 2019: To provide for the long-term improvement of public school facilities.

H.R. 943 - (Bipartisan) Never Again Education Act: To award grants to eligible entities to carry out educational programs about the Holocaust.

H.R. 961 - (Bipartisan) Safeguard American Food Exports Act of 2019: To prevent human health threats posed by the consumption of equines raised in the United States.

H.R. 976 - Air Traffic Noise and Pollution Expert Consensus Act of 2019: To provide for a report on the health impacts of air traffic noise and pollution.

H.R. 1002 - (Bipartisan) WOOF! Act: To amend the Animal Welfare Act to prohibit the issuance of licenses to certain individuals connected to dealers of dogs who have had licenses revoked.

H.R. 1012 - REUNITE Act: To reunite families separated at or near ports of entry.

H.R. 1013 - ICE and CBP Body Camera Accountability Act: To require agents and officers of U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement and U.S. Customs and Border Protection to wear body cameras.

H.R. 1042 - (Bipartisan) PREPARED Act: To amend the Animal Welfare Act to require that covered persons develop and implement emergency contingency plans.

H.R. 1043 - (Bipartisan) Employer Participation in Repayment Act of 2019: Expands the tax exclusion for employer-provided educational assistance to include payments of qualified education loans by an employer to either an employee or a lender.

H.R. 1044 - (Bipartisan) Fairness for High-Skilled Immigrants Act of 2019: To eliminate the per-country numerical limitation for employment-based immigrants, and increase the per-country numerical limitation for family-sponsored immigrants.

H.R. 1050 - ANTIQUITIES Act: To provide for the administration of certain national monuments, to establish a National Monument Enhancement Fund, and to establish certain wilderness areas in the States of New Mexico and Nevada.

H.R. 1074 - Protecting America's Workers Act: To amend the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 to expand coverage under the Act, to increase protections for whistleblowers, to increase penalties for high gravity violations, to adjust penalties for inflation, to provide rights for victims or their family members.

H.R. 1078 - Repatriate Our Patriots Act: To prohibit the removal from the United States of certain veterans, and to expedite their naturalization.

H.R. 1080 - Fairness for Farm Workers Act: to provide increased labor law protections for agricultural workers.

H.R. 1108 - (Bipartisan) Aviation Funding Stability Act of 2019: To provide for funding from the Airport and Airway Trust Fund for all Federal Aviation Administration activities in the event of a Government shutdown.

H.R. 1133 - VA Employee Fairness Act of 2019: To modify authorities relating to the collective bargaining of employees in the Veterans Health Administration.

H.R. 1139 - (Bipartisan) Transit Worker and Pedestrian Protection Act: To require the development of public transportation operations safety risk reduction programs.

H.R. 1140 - (Bipartisan) Rights for Transportation Security Officers Act of 2019: To enhance the security operations of the Transportation Security Administration and stability of the transportation security workforce by applying the personnel system under title 5, United States Code, to employees of the Transportation Security Administration who provide screening of all passengers and property.

H.R. 1146 - Arctic Cultural and Coastal Plain Protection Act: Protects the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge from drilling.

H.R. 1154 - (Bipartisan) Public Safety Employer-Employee Cooperation Act: To provide collective bargaining rights for public safety officers employed by States or their political subdivisions.

H.R. 1162 - Water Recycling Investment and Improvement Act: To establish a grant program for the funding of water recycling and reuse programs.

H.R. 1175 - (Bipartisan) Craft Beverage Modernization and Tax Reform Act: To reform taxation on alcoholic beverages.

H.R. 1185 - FAMILY Act: To provide paid family and medical leave benefits to certain individuals.

H.R. 1186 - Keep Americans Safe Act: To regulate large capacity ammunition feeding devices.

H.R. 1236 - Extreme Risk Protection Order Act of 2019: To support State, Tribal, and local efforts to remove access to firearms from individuals who are a danger to themselves or others pursuant to court orders.

H.R. 1252 - (Bipartisan) To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 6531 Van Nuys Boulevard in Van Nuys, California, as the "Marilyn Monroe Post Office".

H.R. 1253 - (Bipartisan) To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 13507 Van Nuys Boulevard in Pacoima, California, as the "Ritchie Valens Post Office Building".

H.R. 1296 - Assault Weapons Ban: To regulate the sale of assault weapons.

H.R. 1309 - (Bipartisan) Workplace Violence Prevention for Health Care and Social Service Workers Act: To issue an occupational safety and health standard that requires covered employers within the health care and social service industries to develop and implement a comprehensive workplace violence prevention plan.

H.R. 1327 - (Bipartisan) Never Forget the Heroes Act: Permanent Authorization of the September 11th Victim Compensation Fund.

H.R. 1367 - (Bipartisan) CAMRA Act: To amend the Public Health Service Act to authorize a program on children and the media within the National Institutes of Health to study the health and developmental effects of technology on infants, children, and adolescents.

H.R. 1373 - Grand Canyon Centennial Protection Act: To protect, for current and future generations, the watershed, ecosystem, and cultural heritage of the Grand Canyon region in the State of Arizona.

H.R. 1380 - (Bipartisan) Big Cat Public Safety Act: To clarify provisions enacted by the Captive Wildlife Safety Act, and further the conservation of certain wildlife species.

H.R. 1384 - Medicare for All Act of 2019: To ensure affordable and quality healthcare for all Americans.

H.R. 1390 - Mobile Health Record Act of 2019: To promote the ability of individuals entitled to benefits under part A or enrolled under part B of the Medicare program and individuals enrolled under a State plan under the Medicaid program to access their personal medical claim data, including their providers, prescriptions, tests, and diagnoses, through a mobile health record application of the individual's choosing.

H.R. 1393 - Medicare Dental, Vision, and Hearing Benefit Act of 2019: To provide for coverage of dental, vision, and hearing care under the Medicare program.

H.R. 1394 - Medigap Consumer Protection Act of 2019: To provide for certain reforms with respect to medicare supplemental health insurance policies.

H.R. 1396 - (Bipartisan) Hidden Figures Congressional Gold Medal Act: To award Congressional Gold Medals to Katherine Johnson and Dr. Christine Darden, to posthumously award Congressional Gold Medals to Dorothy Vaughan and Mary Jackson, and to award a Congressional Gold Medal to honor all of the women who contributed to the success of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration during the Space Race.

H.R. 1423 - Forced Arbitration Injustice Repeal (FAIR) Act: To prohibit predispute arbitration agreements that force arbitration of future employment, consumer, antitrust, or civil rights disputes, and prohibit agreements and practices that interfere with the right of individuals, workers, and small businesses to participate in a joint, class, or collective action related to an employment, consumer, antitrust, or civil rights dispute.

H.R. 1468 - SAFE Act of 2019: To promote the economic security and safety of survivors of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, or stalking.

H.R. 1551 - (Bipartisan) Quality Care for Moms and Babies Act: To improve the quality, health outcomes, and value of maternity care under the Medicaid and CHIP programs by developing maternity care quality measures and supporting maternity care quality collaboratives.

H.R. 1570 - (Bipartisan) Removing Barriers to Colorectal Cancer Screening Act of 2019: To waive coinsurance under Medicare for colorectal cancer screening tests, regardless of whether therapeutic intervention is required during the screening.

H.R. 1572 - (Bipartisan) Botanical Sciences and Native Plant Materials Research, Restoration, and Promotion Act: To promote botanical research and botanical sciences capacity.

H.R. 1595 - (Bipartisan) SAFE Banking Act of 2019: To create protections for depository institutions that provide financial services to cannabis-related legitimate businesses and service providers for such businesses.

H.R. 1644 - Save the Internet Act of 2019: To restore the open internet order of the Federal Communications Commission.

H.R. 1692 - Equal Access to Abortion Coverage in Health Insurance (EACH Woman) Act of 2019: To ensure affordable abortion coverage and care for every woman.

H.R. 1705 - Jaime's Law: To prevent the purchase of ammunition by prohibited purchasers.

H.R. 1709 - Scientific Integrity Act: To amend the America COMPETES Act to establish certain scientific integrity policies for Federal agencies that fund, conduct, or oversee scientific research.

H.R. 1754 - (Bipartisan) Horseracing Integrity Act of 2019: To improve the integrity and safety of horseracing by requiring a uniform anti-doping and medication control program to be developed and enforced by an independent Horseracing Anti-Doping and Medication Control Authority.

H.R. 1773 - (Bipartisan) Rosie the Riveter Congressional Gold Medal Act of 2019: To award a Congressional Gold Medal, collectively, to the women in the United States who joined the workforce during World War II, providing the aircraft, vehicles, weaponry, ammunition and other material to win the war, that were referred to as “Rosie the Riveter”, in recognition of their contributions to the United States and the inspiration they have provided to ensuing generations.

H.R. 1776 - Captive Primate Safety Act: To prohibit the importation, exportation, transportation, sale, receipt, acquisition, and purchase in interstate or foreign commerce, or in a manner substantially affecting interstate or foreign commerce, of any live animal of any prohibited wildlife species.

H.R. 1792 - (Bipartisan) Ensuring Safe Housing for Our Military Act: To address health, safety, and environmental hazards at private military housing units.

H.R. 1812 - (Bipartisan) Vet Center Eligibility Expansion Act: To furnish Vet Center readjustment counseling and related mental health services.

H.R. 1837 - (Bipartisan) United States-Israel Cooperation Enhancement and Regional Security Act: To make improvements to certain defense and security assistance provisions and to authorize assistance for Israel.

H.R. 1873 - (Bipartisan) Improving HOPE for Alzheimer’s: To provide outreach and reporting on comprehensive Alzheimer’s disease care planning services furnished under the Medicare program.

H.R. 1878 - (Bipartisan) IDEA Full Funding Act: To provide full Federal funding for part B of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act.

H.R. 1884 - Protecting Pre-Existing Conditions and Making Health Care More Affordable Act of 2019: To improve affordability and increase access to health insurance coverage.

H.R. 1897 - MOMMA’s Act: To improve Federal efforts with respect to the prevention of maternal mortality.

H.R. 1941 - Coastal and Marine Economies Protection Act: To prohibit the Department of the Interior from offering any tract for oil and gas leasing in the Atlantic and Pacific Continental Shelf planning areas.

H.R. 1943 - Community Health Center and Primary Care Workforce Expansion Act of 2019: To provide funding for Federally qualified health centers and the National Health Service Corps.

H.R. 1948 - (Bipartisan) Lymphedema Treatment Act of 2019: To provide for Medicare coverage of certain lymphedema compression treatment items as items of durable medical equipment.

H.R. 1968 - (Bipartisan) Shirley Chisholm Congressional Gold Medal Act: To posthumously award a Congressional gold medal to Shirley Chisholm.

H.R. 1976 - (Bipartisan) PFAS Detection Act of 2019: To require the Director of the United States Geological Survey to perform a nationwide survey of perfluorinated compounds.

H.R. 1978 - Fighting Homelessness Through Services and Housing Act: To fight homelessness in the United States by authorizing a grant program within the Health Resources and Services Administration for housing programs that offer comprehensive services and intensive case management for homeless individuals and families.

H.R. 1980 - (Bipartisan) Smithsonian Women’s History Museum Act: To establish in the Smithsonian Institution a comprehensive women’s history museum.

H.R. 1988 - (Bipartisan) Protect Affordable Mortgages for Veterans Act of 2019: To clarify seasoning requirements for certain refinanced mortgage loans.

H.R. 2030 - (Bipartisan) Colorado River Drought Contingency Plan Authorization Act: To execute and carry out agreements concerning Colorado River Drought Contingency Management and Operations.

H.R. 2045 - (Bipartisan) VET OPP Act: To establish the Veterans Economic Opportunity and Transition Administration and the Under Secretary for Veterans Economic Opportunity and Transition of the Department of Veterans Affairs.

H.R. 2088 - To amend the Energy Independence and Security Act of 2007 to reauthorize the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant Program.

H.R. 2096 - (Bipartisan) Energy Storage Tax Incentive and Deployment Act of 2019: To provide tax credits for energy storage technologies.

H.R. 2117 - (Bipartisan) Food Allergy Safety, Treatment, Education, and Research (FASTER) Act of 2019: To improve the health and safety of Americans living with food allergies and related disorders, including potentially life-threatening anaphylaxis, food protein-induced enterocolitis syndrome, and eosinophilic gastrointestinal diseases.

H.R. 2148 - BE HEARD in the Workplace Act: To prevent discrimination and harassment in employment.

H.R. 2164 - Green Bus Act of 2019: To require any bus purchased for use in public transportation with funds provided by the Federal Transit Administration to be a zero-emission bus.

H.R. 2196 - (Bipartisan) To amend title 38, United States Code, to reduce the credit hour requirement for the Edith Nourse Rogers STEM Scholarship program of the Department of Veterans Affairs.

H.R. 2199 - Central Coast Heritage Protection Act: To designate certain Federal land in the state of California as wilderness.

H.R. 2203 - Homeland Security Improvement Act: To increase transparency, accountability, and community engagement within the Department of Homeland Security, provide independent oversight of border security activities, improve training for agents and officers of U.S. Customs and Border Protection and U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement.

H.R. 2208 - (Bipartisan) Cabin Air Safety Act of 2019: To improve the safety of the air supply on commercial aircraft.

H.R. 2214 - NO BAN Act: To transfer and limit Executive Branch authority to suspend or restrict the entry of a class of aliens.

H.R. 2221 - (Bipartisan) Fry Scholarship Improvement Act of 2019: To expand eligibility for the Marine Gunnery Sergeant John David Fry Scholarship to children and spouses of certain deceased members of the Armed Forces.

H.R. 2250 - Northwest California Wilderness, Recreation, and Working Forests Act: To provide for restoration, economic development, recreation, and conservation on Federal lands in Northern California.

H.R. 2256 - Driving America Forward Act: This bill expands the tax credit for new plug-in electric drive motor vehicles and extends the tax credit for new fuel cell motor vehicles.

H.R. 2293 - (Bipartisan) Protecting Access to Wheelchairs Act: To amend the Social Security Act to exclude complex rehabilitative manual wheelchairs from the Medicare competitive acquisition program.

H.R. 2313 - (Bipartisan) Water Conservation Rebate Tax Parity Act: To expand the exclusion for certain conservation subsidies to include subsidies for water conservation or efficiency measures and storm water management measures.

H.R. 2326 - (Bipartisan) Navy SEAL Chief Petty Officer William Bill Mulder (Ret.) Transition Improvement Act of 2019: To improve transition assistance to members of the Armed Forces who separate, retire, or are discharged from the Armed Forces.

H.R. 2337 - FLEET Act: To provide for the upgrade of the vehicle fleet of the United States Postal Service.

H.R. 2339 - Reversing the Youth Tobacco Epidemic Act of 2019: To amend the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act with respect to the sale and marketing of tobacco products.

H.R. 2354 - Prevention of Unconstitutional War with Iran Act of 2019: To limit the use of funds for kinetic military operations in or against Iran.

H.R. 2382 - (Bipartisan) USPS Fairness Act: To repeal the requirement that the United States Postal Service prepay future retirement benefits.

H.R. 2398 - (Bipartisan) To amend the United States Housing Act of 1937 and title 38, United States Code, to expand eligibility for the HUD-VASH program, to direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to submit annual reports to the Committees on Veterans' Affairs of the Senate and House of Representatives regarding homeless veterans.

H.R. 2399 - (Bipartisan) Homes for Our Heroes Act of 2019: To provide greater transparency in the HUD-VASH supported housing program for homeless veterans.

H.R. 2415 - Dignity for Detained Immigrants Act of 2019: To provide standards for facilities at which immigrants in custody of the Department of Homeland Security are detained.

H.R. 2420 - (Bipartisan) National Museum of the American Latino Act: To establish within the Smithsonian Institution the National Museum of the American Latino.

H.R. 2474 - Protecting the Right to Organize Act of 2019: To strengthen protections for workers engaged in collective bargaining to improve their wages, hours, and terms and conditions of employment, and expand coverage to more workers.

H.R. 2481 - (Bipartisan) Gold Star Family Tax Relief Act: This bill treats certain military survivor benefits that are received by children as earned income of the child for the purposes of the kiddie tax (the tax on the unearned income of children). This has the effect of exempting the benefits from such tax.

H.R. 2482 - (Bipartisan) Mainstreaming Addiction Treatment Act of 2019: To eliminate the separate registration requirement for dispensing narcotic drugs in schedule III, IV, or V (such as buprenorphine) for maintenance or detoxification treatment.

H.R. 2508 - (Bipartisan) Better Respiration through Expanding Access to Tele-Health Act: To provide for a pilot program to include respiratory therapists as telehealth practitioners under the Medicare program.

H.R. 2579 - Hardrock Leasing and Reclamation Act of 2019: To modify the requirements applicable to locatable minerals on public domain lands, consistent with the principles of self-initiation of mining claims.

H.R. 2628 - (Bipartisan) VET CARE Act of 2019: To amend title 38, United States Code, to authorize the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to provide administrative support to providers of dental care who provide such care to veterans that is not furnished under such title, and to direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to establish a pilot program for the provision of dental care to certain veterans.

H.R. 2708 - Disarm Hate Act: To prevent a person who has been convicted of a misdemeanor hate crime, or received an enhanced sentence for a misdemeanor because of hate or bias in its commission, from obtaining a firearm.

H.R. 2764 - Zero Emission Vehicles Act of 2019: To create a national zero-emission vehicle standard by the year 2040.

H.R. 2767 - (Bipartisan) SERVE Act: To provide for eating disorders treatment for members and certain former members of the uniformed services, and dependents of such members.

H.R. 2896 - (Bipartisan) SHIELD Act of 2019: To amend title 18, United States Code, to provide that it is unlawful to knowingly distribute private intimate visual depictions with reckless disregard for the individual's lack of consent to the distribution.

H.R. 2912 - (Bipartisan) Military Spouse Hiring Act: To make employers of spouses of military personnel eligible for the work opportunity credit.

H.R. 2924 - (Bipartisan) Housing for Women Veterans Act: To reauthorize the Supportive Services for Veteran Families Grant Program.

H.R. 2931 - SERVE Act of 2019: To direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to provide hospital care, medical services, and nursing home care for certain individuals discharged from service in the Armed Forces by reason of sexual orientation or gender identity.

H.R. 2975 - Women's Health Protection Act of 2019: To protect a woman's ability to determine whether and when to bear a child or end a pregnancy, and to protect a health care provider's ability to provide reproductive health care services, including abortion services.

H.R. 2977 - DISCLOSE Act of 2019: To amend the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 to provide for additional disclosure requirements for corporations, labor organizations, Super PACs and other entities.

H.R. 2995 - Spent Fuel Prioritization Act of 2019: This bill requires the Department of Energy to prioritize the acceptance of high-level radioactive waste or spent nuclear fuel from decommissioned nuclear power reactors located in areas with large populations and a high seismic hazard.

H.R. 3001 - Quiet Communities Act of 2019: To reestablish the Office of Noise Abatement and Control in the Environmental Protection Agency.

H.R. 3005 - (Bipartisan) To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 13308 Midland Road in Poway, California, as the "Ray Chavez Post Office Building".

H.R. 3068 - Offshore Wind Jobs and Opportunity Act: To establish an offshore wind career training grant program.

H.R. 3077 - (Bipartisan) Affordable Housing Credit Improvement Act of 2019: To reform the low-income housing credit.

H.R. 3110 - Climate Security Intelligence Act of 2019: To establish a Climate Security Intelligence Center within the Office of the Director of National Intelligence.

H.R. 3114 - Every Child Deserves a Family Act: To prohibit discrimination on the basis of religion, sex (including sexual orientation and gender identity), and marital status in the administration and provision of child welfare services; to improve safety, well-being, and permanency for lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer/questioning foster youth.

H.R. 3115 - (Bipartisan) Living Shorelines Act of 2019: To direct the Administrator of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration to make grants to State and local governments and nongovernmental organizations for purposes of carrying out climate-resilient living shoreline projects that protect coastal communities by supporting ecosystem functions and habitats with the use of natural materials and systems.

H.R. 3136 - Storage and Transportation of Residual and Excess Nuclear Fuel Act of 2019: To direct the Secretary of Energy to establish a program for the interim storage of high-level radioactive waste and spent nuclear fuel.

H.R. 3144 - (Bipartisan) To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 8520 Michigan Avenue in Whittier, California, as the "Jose Ramos Post Office Building".

H.R. 3155 - (Bipartisan) 75th Anniversary of the End of World War II Commemorative Coin Act: To authorize the minting of a coin in honor of the 75th Anniversary of the end of World War II.

H.R. 3157 - Working Families Tax Relief Act of 2019: To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to expand the earned income and child tax credits.

H.R. 3193 - Transportation Emergency Relief Funds Availability Act: To modify the treatment of deadlines for emergency relief funds awarded by the Secretary of Transportation.

H.R. 3195 - (Bipartisan) Land and Water Conservation Fund Permanent Funding Act: To provide permanent, dedicated funding for the Land and Water Conservation Fund.

H.R. 3224 - (Bipartisan) Deborah Sampson Act: To amend title 38, United States Code, to provide for increased access to Department of Veterans Affairs medical care for women veterans.

H.R. 3225 - Restoring Community Input and Public Protections in Oil and Gas Leasing Act of 2019: To make certain adjustments in leasing on Federal lands for oil and gas drilling.

H.R. 3239 - Humanitarian Standards for Individuals in Customs and Border Protection Custody Act: To require U.S. Customs and Border Protection to perform an initial health screening on detainees.

H.R. 3329 - (Bipartisan) To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 5186 Benito Street in Montclair, California, as the "Paul Eaton Post Office Building".

H.R. 3375 - (Bipartisan) Stopping Bad Robocalls Act: To clarify the prohibitions on making robocalls.

H.R. 3446 - (Bipartisan) National Commission on Scleroderma and Fibrotic Diseases Act of 2019: To establish a National Commission on Fibrotic Diseases.

H.R. 3463 - Public Service Freedom to Negotiate Act of 2019: To secure the rights of public employees to organize, act concertedly, and bargain collectively, which safeguard the public interest and promote the free and unobstructed flow of commerce.

H.R. 3464 - ACTION for National Service Act: To establish a National and Community Service Administration to carry out the national and volunteer service programs, to expand participation in such programs.

H.R. 3504 - (Bipartisan) Ryan Kules Specially Adaptive Housing Improvement Act of 2019: To provide for improvements to the specially adapted housing program and educational assistance programs of the Department of Veterans Affairs.

H.R. 3572 - Redistricting Reform Act of 2019: To require States to carry out Congressional redistricting in accordance with plans developed and enacted into law by independent redistricting commissions.

H.R. 3584 - (Bipartisan) Laboratory Access for Beneficiaries Act: To provide for certain amendments relating to reporting requirements with respect to clinical diagnostic laboratory tests.

H.R. 3589 - (Bipartisan) Greg LeMond Congressional Gold Medal Act: To award a Congressional Gold Medal to Greg LeMond, in recognition of his service to the Nation as an athlete, activist, role model, and community leader.

H.R. 3593 - (Bipartisan) Hot Cars Act of 2019: To require the Secretary of Transportation to issue a rule requiring all new passenger motor vehicles to be equipped with a child safety alert system.

H.R. 3609 - (Bipartisan) Wind Energy Research and Development Act of 2019: To provide for a program of wind energy research, development, and demonstration.

H.R. 3623 - Climate Risk Disclosure Act of 2019: To amend the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 to require issuers to disclose certain activities relating to climate change.

H.R. 3632 - (Bipartisan) Fair and Open Skies Act: To ensure that authorizations issued by the Secretary of Transportation to foreign air carriers do not undermine labor rights or standards.

H.R. 3681 - Green Spaces, Green Vehicles Act of 2019: To establish the Green Spaces, Green Vehicles Initiative to facilitate the installation of zero-emissions vehicle infrastructure on National Forest System land, National Park System land, and certain related land.

H.R. 3723 - Desalination Development Act: To promote desalination project development and drought resilience.

H.R. 3794 - (Bipartisan) Public Land Renewable Energy Development Act of 2019: To promote the development of renewable energy on public lands.

H.R. 3799 - Reuniting Families Act: To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to promote family unity.

H.R. 3825 - To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 401 Main Street in Brawley, California, as the "Helen Fabela Chavez Memorial Post Office Building"

H.R. 3851 - (Bipartisan) Travel Promotion, Enhancement, and Modernization Act of 2019: To extend funding for Brand USA through fiscal year 2027.

H.R. 3895 - North American Development Bank's Pollution Solution Act: To provide for a general capital increase for the North American Development Bank.

H.R. 3938 - (Bipartisan) Gold Star Children Act: To provide that children of certain permanently disabled or deceased veterans shall be preference eligible for purposes of appointments in the civil service.

H.R. 3973 - Clean School Bus Act of 2019: To establish the Clean School Bus Grant Program.
